

Job Posting: Environmental Outreach Intern

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Bay Area Restoration Council (BARC) is offering a temporary position starting in June for up to 8 weeks. The successful candidate will assist with public communications and outreach.

ELIGIBILITY:

Funding requires that the candidate:

- must be between 15-30 years old;
- was registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year and intends to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year;
- is a student in a secondary, post-secondary, vocational or technical program; and
- is a Canadian Citizen.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work shifts at BARC's information kiosk at Bayfront Park. This includes setup and teardown during each shift, providing information to and answering questions from the public.
- Assist in training and overseeing volunteers at the information kiosk.
- Deliver public events such as Marsh Volunteer Planting.
- Assist with planning of annual Dragonboat festival.
- Set up and staff BARC display booth at community events as required.
- Assist with delivery of BARC's education programs as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Enjoyment talking to people in the community.
- Flexible availability as evening/weekend work is required.
- A valid driver's license and regular access to a vehicle.
- A clear Police Vulnerable Sector Check (PVSC) is required of the successful candidate (paid for by BARC).
- Passion for environmental issues.
- Demonstrated ability to work without supervision.
- Experience working with children an asset

RATE OF PAY:

\$14 per hour at 30 hours/week. Overtime may be required with time taken off in lieu.
